- October 21, 2019 — Final names to Northwest Youth Services
- November 8, 2019 — 2019 Light Their Path Gala

Table Captain Guide

I. Getting started

Invite potential guests. Make a list of 15 people who you might want to attend at your table, ensuring enough folks are asked to fill the 7 seats at your table (you are guest No. 1!)

Extend the invitation by phone, letter, email or our favorite – in person. We’ve provided a sample email invitation for you on page 8 of this packet. Make sure to attach or hand them a save the date or invitation card so it is official.

We’ll be sure to provide you with gala save the dates and invitations. Please let us know if we can provide branded greeting cards or other supplies to make the invite process best fit your guest’s needs.

II. Possible Responses

If your guest says: “Yes! I would love to attend!” You might respond —

I am so glad you will be able to join me!

I have attached the event information to this email for you. Northwest Youth Services will look forward to sending you a reminder with directions and parking information in the days leading up to the gala. In the meantime,

[OPTION 1: *If sponsoring the whole table*] please send me your meal choice (salmon, filet mignon or vegan stuffed mushroom).

[OPTION 2: *If having guests purchase tickets independently*] please be sure to reserve your ticket online at www.NWYS.org and indicate you are my table guest on the drop down menu.

III. Registering Your Guests

You and your guests can confirm your attendance in one of the following ways, depending how tickets will be paid for:

1. Sponsor your table by completing the registration online at www.NWYS.org. Fill out the guest attendee chart, downloaded from our website at www.NWYS.org, adding in additional guests in the fields provided. Submit the chart via email to SigourneyG@NWYS.org as often as you confirm new guests.
2. Ask your guests to register themselves by filling out the online registration form and selecting your name from a drop-down list of Table Captains.

All tables accommodate 8 guests comfortably. Should you have additional guests, we will seat them at a second table adjacent to you. You are also welcome to fill more than one table, let us know if filling multiple tables is of interest to you.

IV. Finalizing your table

Please plan to confirm your guests with Northwest Youth Services by Oct. 4th. Final changes, additions and details should be submitted by Oct. 21st to ensure the best possible experience for your guests.

We will confirm all details with you by Friday, Oct. 25.

V. Before the event

You will be a key contact for guests prior to the event. Get your guests excited by sharing information about the organization and/or a reminder email.

VI. At the event

Welcome and meet your guests. Show them around the venue, introduce your guests to Northwest Youth Services and share why Northwest Youth Services matters to you!

VII. After the event

Please thank your guests for their generous support of Northwest Youths Services. Introduce guests who are interested in learning more to Northwest Youth Services staff.

Pre-event checklist

Starting Now

- Create your guest list.
- Send invitation emails to each person - view save the date template email on page 8.

August- October

- Check in with those who you have not heard from.
- For those who cannot attend, send them a link to Northwest Youth Services donation page.
- Register your table or confirm that your guests have registered.

1 Month before

- Check in with all guests.
- Verify dietary requests were made at registration.
- Submit any missing contact information for your guests to SigourneyG@NWYS.org

October 21, 2019

- Confirm final guest list – including all names, meal choices, guest contact information and any special requests.

1 Week before

All guests will receive an emailed event reminder from Northwest Youth Services.

- Contact your guests a few days prior to the event and encourage a 6:00 arrival.
- A fun thing that some table captains do is table seating cards, chocolates or notes to guests at your table.

Day of Gala

- Arrive at 5:50.
- Greet your guests and have fun!
